



DCF Brighter Futures Eligibility Checklist

You will Need All the Items Listed Below:

- Attending secondary school
- Not younger than age 14 or older than 21
- Eligible to work in the United States Note: Though youth under age 16 must have a work permit to obtain employment in Wisconsin, ISY ages 14 and 15 may participate in the Youth Program without a work permit if they meet the definition of "eligible to work in the United States."
- Registered for Selective Service (if applicable)

AND

You Need One of the Items Listed Below (Check all that apply and include documentation of criteria selected):

- Incomplete or Missing Academic & Career Plan (ACP)
- Low Academic Proficiency or Credit Accumulation
- Basic Skill Deficiency in Math and/or Reading
- School Attendance Rate Below 95%
- No Prior Work History
- Behavior Concerns Such as Suspensions or Office Referrals
- Has a Disability
