Eligibility Requirements

- · High school diploma or GED required
- · Valid driver's license
- 6+ months of customer service experience for phlebotomists and 1 year of professional driving experience
- Must submit to a background check, drug screen and MVR check
- All employees must be vaccinated against COVID-19 prior to start date (single dose of Johnson & Johnson or two doses of Pfizer/Moderna/Novavax), or have approved accommodation
