Field trips scheduled for the kids Discovery World, Havenswoods State Forest, Brewers Game, Incrediroll, and Jones Island. Earn & Learn has 2600 Registrations started, 1128 participants registered, 1201 job opportunities at 117 worksites. First day of work is June 20th and last day is August 6th, the end of the summer celebration will take place August 5th at Employ Milwaukee. YouthBuild grant was awarded on May 1, 2023, for \$1,496,882 and will begin on June 1st, 2023. Cream City YouthBuild will provide industry training in construction.
